Reading of Minutes: The minutes were read and accepted.

Reports from committees:

Financial Report: Financial report was presented and accepted. There was a discussion about the surplus in the account. One suggestion was to lower the cost of the dinner tickets and have the association cover the difference. This led to a discussion of options for the annual awards ceremony including having the annual meeting include the awards.

Youth Committee: City tournament was held. Youth program has grown with Scott Moore introducing new ideas. Youth will be having a bowlathon instead of basket raffles. It was pointed out that the Perreault tournament needs more publicity.

Bowlers of the Month: Adult is Stacey Weymouth of Mamas and Papas. Youth minors is Camryn Wyman and Youth Majors is Savannah Barnes. The name of the adult award will be changed to "Judy Marshall Bowler of the Month".

Old Business:

800 Plaque: Plaque is almost finished. It will be picked up this week.

City Tournament. The prize money will be allocated based on number of entries. Mark Fortier will produce a flyer for potential sponsors. \$100 per full page. \$75/\$45/\$20 for discount coupon. Cost is \$20 per entry. Handicap is 100% of 240 for both divisions. First year bowlers will have their all events fee paid by the tournament.

Annual Awards Dinner Financial report was presented. It was suggested that the bowling center not be given free dinner tickets due to discontinuance of sponsorship. Motion was accepted. President will decide who, if any-one, gets free tickets.

BVL Tournament: 59 entries were received. We paid out four winners totaling \$30. \$30 will be donated to BVL. Caleb Burgess was the winner. In addition to the prize money, he received a certificate. \$170 will be added to this year's donation to BVL. \$200 supplemented will be added to the annual budget.

New Bowler Outreach: USBC was contacted about the program they want us to put on. They were asked if we had support and USBC said that they would give us whatever support we needed. Certified coaches have been contacted but no one has responded yet. Scott Moore suggested we hold a clinic with local experienced bowlers teaching first and second year bowlers.

Hall of Fame Committee Recommendations: Committee recommended a minimum age of 35 and also allowing the ex-officio voting right in the case of an absent Hall of Fame committee member. Recommendations have been adopted. Two alternates will be added. One will be current board member and the other will be current hall of fame member. Meeting will be held with 7 voting members.

New Business:

Local Award Pins: There are a number of local pins being left behind by bowlers. Tom Giberti suggested we look into alternatives.

Senior Tournament Reimbursement: Will be drawn on Thursday night.

Qualifications for Memorial Plaque: Bowlers who had bowled for 10 or more years will qualify for being placed on the memorial plaque.
